## Directions:

Medtronic World Headquarter locates at the northwestern corner of the I-694/65 cross.

**From West:** Take I-694 East, take north on 65/Central exit, stay on the left lane, and turn left (west) on Medtronic Parkway.

**From East:** Take I-694 west, take north on 65/Central exit, stay on the left lane, and turn left (west) on Medtronic Parkway.

**From South:** Take 35-W north and turn west on I-694. Then take north on 65/Central exit, stay on the left lane, and turn left (west) on Medtronic Parkway.

The parking ramp is on your left side. Enter the building from the east gate on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.
